With a main source of funding from a bond issue, the City embarked upon a 4,683 sq. ft. addition, as well as renovations to 7,934 sq. ft. of the existing library. A secondary source of funding utilized an Energy Efficient and Conservation Block Grant. Improvements consisted of adding a community room, conference spaces, expansion of the service and operators area, as well as the children and computer areas. Additional enhancements included high efficiency windows and lighting replacement, electrical/HVAC upgrades, and expansion to multiple public areas.
